f<u>LA</u>uta will be a diverse and exciting program of 20th and 21st century solo and chamber works written by composers currently living in Los Angeles. Flutist Rachel Mellis and pianist Mitsuko Morikawa will be featured, and will be joined by several other artists throughout the performance. The evening will include a world premiere and other selections for flute, alto flute, piccolo, world flutes, piano, electronics, and more!

GPS's 2019 Season presents three concerts that cover dynamic musical landscapes, encompassing genres such as Classical, Jazz and beyond. The season includes jazz flutist Michael Morton (4/27). Taiwanese bel canto soprano Lin-lin Chang will travel to Los Angeles to collaborate with The Alan Chan Jazz Orchestra for a concert titled "The Trans-Pacific Songbook," during her American tour, on September 1.

Now celebrating its tenth season, GPS has welcomed over a hundred accomplished artists from around the country and abroad, encompassing a variety of artistic disciplines including music, visual arts and poetry, to forging collaborations since 2009.
